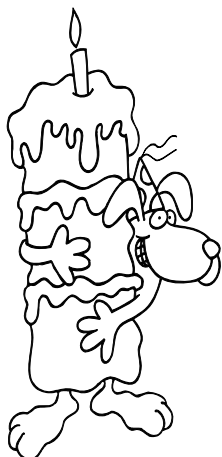

'I am ashamed of you son,' said John. 'When I was your age, I never lied to my parents.'

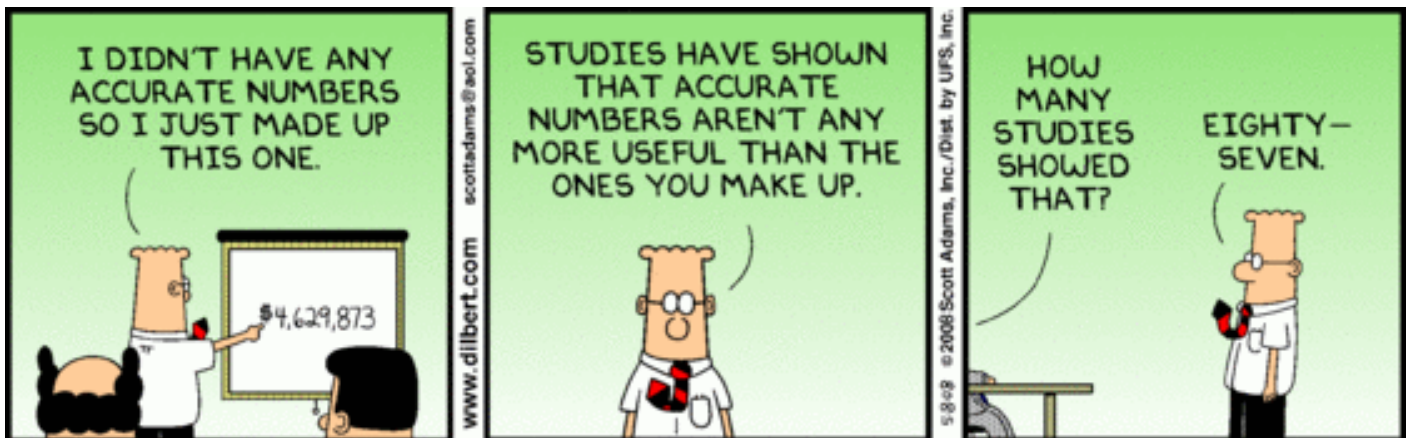
The robot then walked around to John and delivered a whack that nearly knocked him out of his chair.
